The Office of International Cooperation and Collaboration Centre (ICCC), Noakhali Science and Technology University (NSTU) is delighted to inform all concerned that the **Graduate School of Science** and **Technology (GSST), Kumamoto University, Japan** has invited applications from the qualified students of the designated departments of the NSTU for participating in the **IJEP Short Term Exchange Program with JASSO Scholarship** to study master's course in the aforesaid University for the **period of six months for the Fall Semester Commencing from October 1, 2025.**

Program Name: IJEP Short Term Exchange Program-2025

Academic Requirements: The students interested for participating in this exchange program should have at least the CGPA of 3.50 in the Bachelor program or in the TGPA of 3.50 in the first term of the Master's Exam with the CGPA of 3.50 in the Bachelor Program, adequate English proficiency, and a valid passport.

Please be informed that the applicants should have a valid IELTS score (overall band score of 6.0) or TOEFL score (PBT 530 or equivalent in IBT) as per the norms of the scholarship. Hence, the educational qualification of the applicants may be relaxed, in case of having a valid IELTS or TOEFL score.

Designated Departments: ACCE, Applied Mathematics, BMB, CSTE, EEE, and ESDM.

How to apply: The Interested students have to send their applications in a prescribed form with a recommendation letter from their respective Chairman, attested copies of all academic transcripts, *proofs of the medium of instruction*, and other relevant achievements (e.g. research paper, co-curricular activities, recognitions, and so on), to the Office of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Director of ICCC), Administrative Building, NSTU by hand. The prescribed application form will have to be collected from the NSTU website.

Please note that when submitting the applications, the applicants have to attach all the documents nicely to the application form, enclosing them inside an A4-size envelope. Kindly ensure that the name of the program is indicated on the envelope.

Last Date of Application: April 27, 2025, during office hours.

Please note that the NSTU authority reserves all the rights in this selection process. Please also note that the nominated student has to complete all the required courses as per the course-curriculum of the Department of the NSTU concerned.
