



Re-announcement of the Erasmus+ Short-Term Student Mobility in KBU, Turkiye-2026 (Doctoral Short-Term Research Internship Program)

The Office of International Collaboration and External Affairs (ICEA), the Noakhali Science and Technology University (NSTU) is delighted to inform all concerned that the Karabuk University (KBU) Turkiye has invited applications from the qualified doctoral students of the designated departments of the NSTU for participating in the Erasmus + Short-Term Student Mobility Program to pursue research for two months commencing from April 13, 2026 as part of Erasmus + KA 171. Please note that the program will be fully funded by the European Union (EU) as part of Erasmus + KA 171. Please also note that one (01) student will be selected via proper process under this program.

Required Qualification:

The students interested for participating in this exchange program should have a bachelor and master's degrees in the relevant disciplines with a CGPA of at least 3.35 (On a scale of 4.0), should be enrolled in PhD programs in the relevant disciplines or departments of the NSTU, adequate English proficiency (preferably a valid IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent TOEFL score), research backgrounds and a valid passport. However, IELTS requirement may be exempted in case of the candidates having the medium of instructions in English in both bachelor and master's programs and sound research backgrounds.

How to Apply:

The interested students have to send their applications in a prescribed form enclosing the attested copies of all transcripts, certificate of medium of instructions, a proof of language proficiency, a recommendation letter issued by the departmental chairman and respective supervisor, the first pages of the copies of published papers and a copy of passport to the Erasmus Coordinator via email (rokonsiddiky.soc@nstu.edu.bd) by February 04, 2026. While sending applications, the applicants are required to put CC to ICEA Office (international@office.nstu.edu.bd). Please note that while submitting the applications via email, the applicants have to merge all the documents in order and transform them into a single pdf file. Please also note that the NSTU authority reserves all the rights in this selection process.
