



## Announcement of the International Staff Week in SUBU, Turkiye-2026

The Office of International Collaboration and External Affairs (ICEA), the Noakhali Science and Technology University (NSTU) is delighted to inform all concerned that the Sakarya University of Applied Sciences (SUBU), Turkiye has invited applications from the faculty-members of the NSTU for participating in the International Staff Week Program for networking, cultural exchange, professional development, and knowledge sharing to be organized by SUBU from May 18, 2026 to May 22, 2026. Please note that the program will be hosted by the SUBU. However, the faculty-members who will be nominated for this program may receive full funding depending on the availability of the budget of the host university.

### Required Qualification:

The persons interested in participating in this program should be permanent faculty-members serving in any department of the NSTU in the rank of associate professor or professor with a doctoral degree from any reputed university and having proficiency in English and a vast research experience in their fields. The candidates having expertise in artificial intelligence, finance or business, engineering, health sciences and sustainability will be given preference. Please also note that two faculty-members will be selected via proper process under this program, of whom one will be an associate professor and another will be a professor.

### How to Apply:

The interested faculty-members have to send their applications in a prescribed form, list of all publications, the copies of the papers published in the journals indexed in Scopus, proof of any recognition or award at national or international level, and a copy of passport to the Erasmus Coordinator via email ([rokonsiddiky.soc@nstu.edu.bd](mailto:rokonsiddiky.soc@nstu.edu.bd)) by January 27, 2026. While sending applications, the applicants are required to put CC to ICEA Office ([international@office.nstu.edu.bd](mailto:international@office.nstu.edu.bd)). Please note that while submitting the applications via email, the applicants should preferably merge all the documents in order and transform them into a single pdf file. Please also note that the NSTU authority reserves all the rights in this selection process.
