Re-announcement of the IJEP Short Term Exchange Program-2025

The Office of International Cooperation and Collaboration Centre (ICCC), the Noakhali Science and Technology University (NSTU) is delighted to inform all concerned that the **Graduate School of Science and Technology (GSST)**, **Kumamoto University**, **Japan** has invited applications from the qualified students of the designated departments of the NSTU for participating in the **IJEP Short Term Exchange Program with JASSO Scholarship** to study master's course in the aforesaid University for the **period of six months for the Fall Semester Commencing from October 1, 2025**.

The students interested for participating in this exchange program should have at least the CGPA of 3.50 in the Bachelor program or in the TGPA of 3.50 in the first term of the Master's Exam with the CGPA of 3.50 in the Bachelor Program, adequate English proficiency, and a valid passport. However, the educational qualification of the applicants may be relaxed, in case of the applicants having good English language proficiency (preferably a valid IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent TOEFL score), a valid passport, and good research background in their respective fields of study.

The interested students have to send their applications in a prescribed form enclosing the attested copies of all academic transcripts, certificate of medium of instructions, and proofs of language proficiency and other relevant achievements (e.g. research papers, co-curricular activities, recognitions, and so on) to the Additional Director and Erasmus Coordinator via email (rokonsiddiky.soc@nstu.edu.bd) by May 10, 2025.

Please note that while submitting the applications via email, the applicants have to merge all the documents nicely with the application and transform the whole application set into a single pdf file. Please also note that the NSTU authority reserves all the rights in this selection process.

N.B.: The students who applied previously do not need to reapply.
